









E-SCOOTERS

E-SCOOTERS ARE A CONVENIENT MODE OF TRANSPORT, BUT YOU HAVE A DUTY OF CARE TO YOURSELF AND OTHER ROAD USERS. YOU ALSO NEED TO BE SURE THAT YOUR E-SCOOTER IS ROAD LEGAL




E-scooters are restricted to

-  A maximum weight unladen 25 kilograms
-  A maximum design speed of 20 kilometers per hour
-  A maximum power of 400 W




E- scooters must have

-  Front and rear lights
-  A bell or horn
-  Front and rear brakes

E-scooters are not allowed

-  On footpaths or motorways
-  To carry passengers or goods
-  To have a seat

E-scooter users

-  Must be over 16 years old
-  Cannot use the scooter while intoxicated
-  Failures to adhere to road traffic legislation may incur a fine or a court summons

Although personal protection equipment is not compulsory it is strongly recommended
